



MTC Covid Safe Working Practices at CSK

Dated 12th April 2022

My Town Choir (MTC) is committed to following working practices that help ensure that their staff and members are kept as safe as possible from the dangers of the Covid 19 virus whilst carrying out our activities. We will achieve this by following these guidelines.

- We will review these practices on a weekly basis, following the latest advice from the UK government.
- We will always take a lead from government regulations and adjust our behaviour according to the latest guidelines.
- Restrictions have been lifted; however, we will still currently carry out the following measures:
 - Hand sanitiser will be made available both at the entrance and within the hall.
 - We will sanitise door handles, light switches, furniture and WC facilities at the start and end of every session if government advice or venue risk assessment recommends so.
 - Adequate ventilation will be supplied in the hall by opening windows and/or doors.
 - No person shall be asked to sing whilst facing towards another. All singing should take place either side-by-side or facing away from each other.
 - We will keep a register of those attending with contact details for at least 21 days.
 - After the session has finished and ALL members have left, MTC staff will wipe down door handles and light switches with Antiviral wipes. They will also spray seats and worship area surfaces with antiviral spray. All products must be suitable for use against Covid-19 and be non-harmful to the fabric of the building.
- No staff or member will attend if they are feeling unwell or have a raised temperature.
